

The First Running

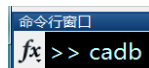
The software operates independently of any external toolbox of Matlab.

It is a bit hassle to run “cadb” by typing several commands. But “cadb” could add a shortcut (changed to be **favorite commands** after Matlab 2018a), which means subsequent running only needs one mouse click. Therefore, only the first running needs typing commands, and here is how.

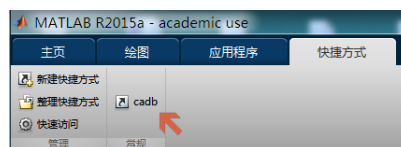
Launch Matlab, and change its “Current Folder” to where “cadb” is installed. In the example of the following figure, the software is installed in folder “cadb” on the desktop.



In the “Command Window” of Matlab, type “cadb” to run the software, as shown in the following figure.



Allow the software to add a shortcut to “cadb”, and the following figure shows what the shortcut looks like.



From now on, clicking the shortcut will launch the software no matter what the “Current Folder” of Matlab is.

On Matlab newer than 2018a, the aforementioned shortcuts become favorite commands. When the favorite command is added for “cadb”, the icon can be found on the upper right corner of the Matlab window.
