I am pleased to announce that Ke LI Xu has been awarded a Ray A. Rothrock '77 Fellowship. This Fellowship program is intended to recognize annually up to three newly-promoted, highly recommended associate professors from the College of Liberal Arts with three-year awards of \$5000 per year. The award is intended to encourage and support the completion of exceptionally promising post-promotion projects and continued outstanding teaching that should lead to a successful recommendation for promotion to professor in 5-6 years and would enable the recipient to make singular contributions in research, teaching, and service to the department, college, and university.
